### Selection criteria by modality:

Candidates who submit all documentation and meet the requirements listed in the Capes PrInt Notice and the "PR2 Guidelines" will be considered fit and classified according to the following criteria:

- Sandwich Doctoral Scholarships: Academic performance and Scientific Production considering the same weights currently used for the distribution of doctoral scholarships;
- Postdoctoral Scholarship with experience abroad: Academic performance and Scientific Production considering the same weights for the distribution of PNPD scholarships;
- 3-month scholarship for senior pec professor conduct internship abroad: Number of articles indexed in jcr in the last 5 years;
- Visiting professor from abroad for 1 month in Brazil: Number of articles indexed in the JCR authored by the candidate in the last 5 years;
- Missions abroad for teachers: Number of articles indexed in jcr in the last 5 years;

For all modalities, eligible countries of origin (scholarships in Brazil) or destination (overseas scholarships) are:

#### Theme: Sustainability, Growth and Combating Inequalities

The project must be related to the theme "Sustainability, Growth and Combating Inequalities", whose summary is presented below:

The growth of societies will only result in sustainable socioeconomic development if it is articulated to combating inequalities. Thus, research is needed to develop techniques and products, propose theoretical analyses and critical discussions on growth in their different dimensions - economic, demographic, technological, urban, educational - and that seek inequalities, result from the processes of exploitation of natural resources, whether social, political or legal engendered in today's society. We understand that these processes result in forms of social, racial, ethnic, economic, religious, orientation and sexual identity, gender, etc., which manifest themselves in institutions, power relations, policies, norms and rights, which stimulate or combat, in many aspects, both growth and inequalities. Such investigations and actions, developed in the various fields of knowledge, respond to Brazilian demands and that of different countries, and aim to foster the production of knowledge that collaborates in coping with these problems, as well as the construction of networks international, multi and interdisciplinary research, which give visibility to research developed at UFRJ and its partners on such issues.
